First, we went to Kirkjulækjarkot and did some construction work on a meeting place for churches, conferences, kids, and community members. Finally, we split into three groups and went to Höfn, Ísafjörður, and Vestmannaeyjar to do specific ministries there.

We went to downtown and the University of Iceland throughout the week. One of the team members and I met 2 women while we were at the university and actually met up with them during our free day! Hopefully, us taking the time to meet up with them made them curious about why. At the university, we also did surveys that asked people about faith and what they believe. I was surprised at how many people opened up to us about their faith because a lot of people in Iceland think that is a personal matter and don't talk about it. I got to share the Gospel with so many people and that was so encouraging! I'm believing that God will water all of the seeds we planted throughout the week!
