KIDS OUTREACH

We spent time playing with them through hula hoops, jump ropes, face painting, water balloons, and soccer. The kids had so much fun playing with us and were radiating joy. Then, a few members of the team shared their testimonies each day so the kids could hear how amazing our God is! Not even a language barrier was going to stop us from telling of the goodness of God! The children's pastor of the church was with us, so she was able to share the Gospel story with the kids, and they were all so engaged. This was encouraging to see, especially as a future teacher, because kids are hungry for the Lord and so receptive! It was so much fun to experience!

I had the privilege and honor of leading a trip of my fellow college students to Malawi! We got to partner with the church there and serve alongside them doing door-to-door evangelism in the villages and putting on a kids outreach.

EVANGELISM

Over 3 days, our team split up into groups with some of the leaders and members of the church. In Malawi they speak Chichewa, so we had to have a translator while in the villages (which was a brand new experience for me!). We had a lot of great conversations with people, and we got to share the Gospel with them. Some highlights were that I led someone in the salvation prayer for the first time, we got to pray over everyone we met, and I got to explain what baptism was to one man. He was asking me questions about what it meant, and he said that he wanted to give his life to Christ! Another cool part...this was all happening in front of a Muslim, so I pray that a seed was planted for God to water!

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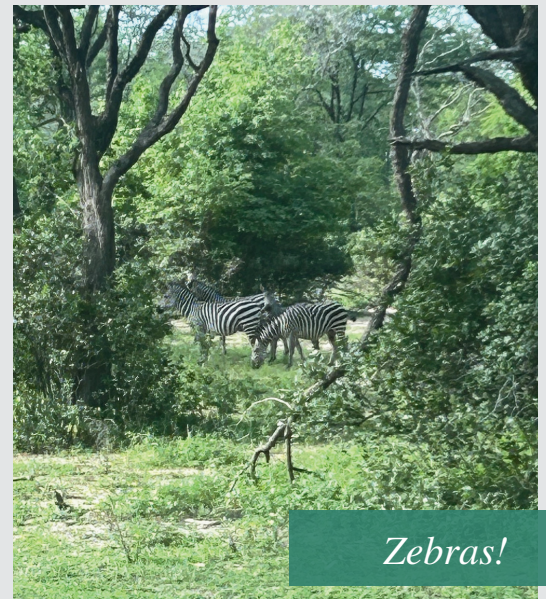
Elephant!
