Man's state wasn't good:
"Alone" (Gen. 2:18)

Man needed a "helper"
that corresponds to him
(ēzer - typically used of
God as a helper for man)
(Gen. 2:18)

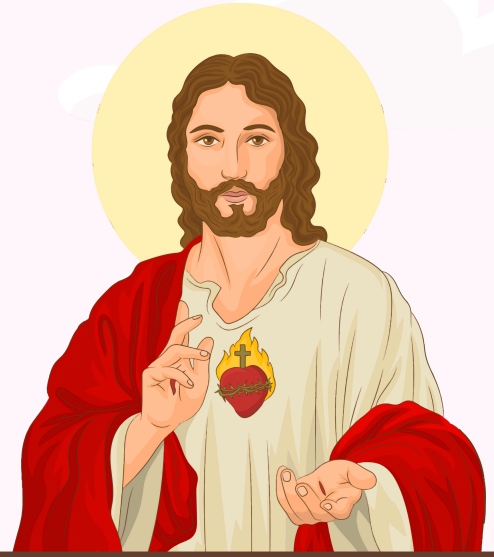
Adam put into a deep
sleep "symbolizes being
put to death" (Gen.
2:21)

Adam's side "pierced"
to take his rib (ṣēlā', the
word for rib, can also
mean side) (Gen. 2:21)

Adam awakened
"symbolizing being
resurrected"
(Gen. 2:21-22)

Woman was born out of
Adams sacrifice (rib)
(Gen. 2:22)

Woman (bride)
Presented to Adam
(Gen. 2:22)



JESUS

Man's state wasn't good:
"Sin" (Gen. 3)

Man needed a "helper"
that corresponds to him
(God encoded Himself
into humanity to
address sin) (Gen. 3:15;
Lk. 1:31-33; Is. 9:6)

Jesus put to death on
the cross (Matt. 27:35,
50; Mk. 15:24, 37; Lk.
23:33, 46; Jn. 19:18, 30)

Jesus' side is pierced
(Jn. 19:33-34)

Jesus raised from the
dead
(Matt. 28:5-6; Mk. 16:6;
Lk. 24:6-7; Jn. 20:11-14)

The church was born
out of Jesus' sacrifice
(Eph. 5:25-26)

The church (Bride of
Christ) is presented to
Him (Eph. 5:27; Rev.
19:7-9)
